Your adventure will conclude with a flight over Lake Mead, Fortification Hill, an extinct volcano, and Hoover Dam at dusk. Enjoy the sunset as you finish your tour with an exciting flight over Downtown Las Vegas and past the Bellagio, Luxor, Paris and many more mega resorts of the Las Vegas Strip.

This tour offers extended ground times to stroll through the Indian Village, watch a cultural performance by native dancers and visit the Hualapai Ranch. Enjoy lunch at one of three eateries, then marvel at the view from the rim. Bring your camera for many photo opportunities and view the Skywalk, a glass bridge, extending 70 feet over the Grand Canyon.

## **RIVER RAFTING TOUR** **Helicopter and Rafting Combo Adventure**

One of the most amazing ways to experience the Grand Canyon is with a landing tour and the added bonus of river rafting through the scenic Black Canyon on the Colorado River.

With this tour you will enjoy a helicopter adventure through the Grand Canyon and see awe-inspiring scenery at one of the greatest natural wonders of the world. Following the helicopter tour, you will land at the Boulder City Airport and meet up with the rafting crew.

Below is a list of suggested items to wear or bring with you on your river rafting trip. Keep in mind that the water temperature averages 50°F. Check the weather at the Grand Canyon before your trip since it varies throughout the year. Remember that the temperature at the West Rim is approximately 5-10°F cooler than in Las Vegas.

- Quick-drying shorts. Nylon is the preferred fabric for shorts or pants. Jeans are not recommended since they can weigh you down and dry slowly. The key is to wear fabric that will dry quickly.
- Cotton T-shirt. A T-shirt is lightweight so it will help you stay cool and keep the sun from burning you. Avoid heavier fabrics or shirts with long sleeves that will make it difficult to swim.
- Hat with a brim. It can be a baseball cap, bucket hat or a sun hat with a wide brim. Just make sure that it provides your face with some shade from the sun.
- Tennis shoes. Select a pair of old athletic shoes with laces or Velcro closure. Be sure that they fit securely and won't slip off. Do not wear flip-flops or boots.
- Sunglasses. Leave your designer frames at home so they don't get damaged during the trip. We also suggest having a retention strap on your sunglasses so you don't lose them.



- Swimsuit. Many people find it easier to wear a swimsuit as their undergarments in case they get wet or want to take a dip in the cool water. Your fully motorized and narrated river rafting voyage will depart from the base of Hoover Dam and float 12 miles down the grand Colorado River. The Colorado River rafting tour includes several stops along the river and lunch served upon reaching Willow Beach, Arizona. The rafting crew will transport you to your hotel at the conclusion of the tour.

## INDIAN TERRITORY TOUR

### Grand Canyon West Helicopter Experience



Your tour will begin as you fly over the beautiful Lake Las Vegas, Lake Mead, the world-famous Hoover Dam and Fortification Hill, an extinct volcano. Along the way you'll see breathtaking scenery and wildlife of the Southwest.

You will descend and land 3,500 feet into the Grand Canyon in Hualapai Indian Territory. You will be served champagne and beverages some 300 feet above the mighty Colorado River surrounded by one of the greatest natural wonders of the world.



You will journey back through the Grand Canyon and land on the West Rim, where you will enjoy the spectacular views at Eagle Point and receive a brief introduction to the Hualapai Indian legends and culture. Then you'll head to Guano Point, a breathtaking observation spot overlooking the Grand Canyon where you will be served a light meal.

The Grand Canyon Skywalk, the new glass bridge attraction, is an optional activity on this tour. Additional activities can be arranged when you arrive at Grand Canyon West.

After your stay at the West Rim, you will set out towards Las Vegas through the Valley of Fire and conclude the journey with a flight over the Las Vegas Strip.

The vision of the skywalk was to enable visitors to walk beyond the canyon walls, becoming surrounded by the Grand Canyon while standing at the edge of a glass bridge. This glass bridge is suspended more than 4,000 feet above the Colorado River on the very edge of the Grand Canyon's West Rim. The Skywalk tour is an optional activity on this adventure and can be purchased directly through Aria tour desk.
