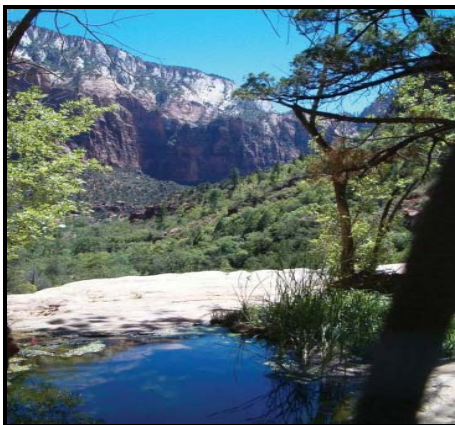
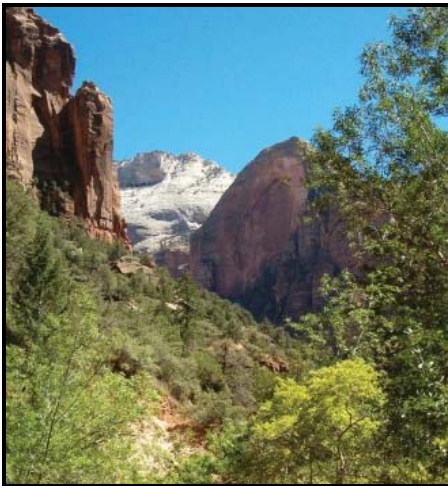
Zion National Park

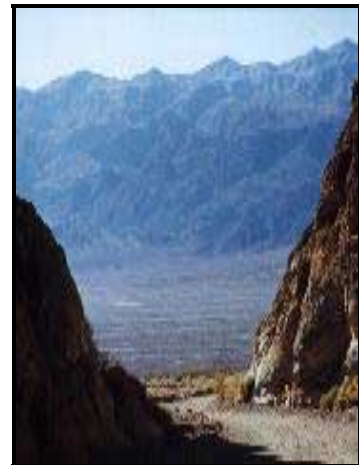
Death Valley National Park

You will also visit Zabriskie's Point, the Devils Golf Course, Furnace Creek Museum, the Salt Lake, the Sand Dunes and Artists Pallet.
